America's natural gas and oil industry supports 9 million U.S. jobs and adds more than \$1 trillion to the national economy each year. It is estimated that by investing in more domestic natural gas and oil production, a million new jobs could be created over the next decade.

Oklahoma's abundance of natural gas reserves gives our state a significant economic advantage by playing a vital role in creating quality jobs. Additionally, natural gas is an essential ingredient in many of our nation's industries such as the production of steel, chemicals, plastics and more. With companies using natural gas for manufacturing and production, billions of dollars are being spent on new investments, creating many new jobs along the way throughout the United States.

The average income for workers in the natural gas and oil industry is \$107,000.

Employees in the natural gas and oil industry come from a variety of backgrounds and work in a wide variety of jobs. In an industry this large, the employment possibilities are endless!
